II. General information on data processing, categories of data processed

We shall always observe the applicable data protection provisions when processing the personal data of our customers, suppliers and other contractual partners ("**business partners**").

As part of our collaboration with business partners, we shall process personal data for the following purposes:

- To maintain business communication, e.g. regarding products, services and projects;
- To organise, maintain and manage business relations;
- To carry out customer surveys, marketing campaigns, market research, competitions, sweepstakes, and other similar campaigns and events;
- To maintain and safeguard the security of our products, services and website, and to detect and prevent security risks, fraudulent activity and other criminal or intentionally harmful acts;
- To comply with legal requirements (e.g. data retention obligations imposed by tax and commercial law), guidelines and industry standards;
- To execute contracts, and to assert, exercise, enforce and defend legal claims; and
- To settle legal disputes.

In accordance with the purposes listed above, we shall process the following categories of personal data:

- Contact data, e.g. first and last name, business address, business phone number, business mobile number, business fax number and business email address;
- Payment details, e.g. information required to process payments and prevent fraud, including credit card information and card verification numbers;
- Other information which must be processed to carry out a project or contractual relationship with us, or which is provided voluntarily by our contacts, e.g. orders placed, enquiries made and project details;
- Information collected from publicly accessible sources, databases or credit agencies.

Personal data shall only be processed for the purposes listed above. These purposes are generally necessary for the fulfilment of our contractual obligations or the safeguarding of our prevailing legitimate interests. Our legitimate interests are based on the execution of our business purpose.

III. Transfer and disclosure of personal data

In accordance with the purposes listed above, we shall transfer personal data to:

- Other service providers, provided this is necessary for the fulfilment of such purposes;
- Courts, supervisory authorities and law firms, provided this is legally permissible or necessary to comply with applicable legislation, or to assert, exercise or defend legal claims;
- Processors, e.g. IT maintenance service providers. These service providers are bound by our instructions as the Controller and contractually obliged to comply with applicable data protection requirements.

If any of these data recipients are located in countries outside the European Economic Area (“third countries”) and the applicable law in such countries does not guarantee the same level of data protection as in your home country, we shall take appropriate and adequate measures to ensure the protection of your personal data. We shall only transfer personal data to recipients in third countries if:

- (i) They have concluded EU standard contractual clauses with us as the Controller; or
- (ii) They have incorporated binding corporate rules; or
- (iii) Recipients based in the USA are certified under the EU-US Privacy Shield programme.

IV. Retention periods

Personal data shall be deleted or blocked as soon as it is no longer required for the original purpose, unless a specific retention period is explicitly indicated when the data is collected. Personal data may also be stored if such a retention is provided for by the European or German legislation contained in EU directives, laws or other regulations to which the Controller is subject. Personal data shall be deleted or blocked at the end of the retention periods contained in such legislation, unless the data is required for the conclusion or performance of a contract.
